- 2 **Column headings:**

Population - Number of people in each wage bracket

Pop. With - Population within each wage bracket who have internet

Pop. Without - Population within each wage bracketed who don't have internet

With Dist. - Comparison of the percentage with, to the population of all those with internet

Without Dist. - Comparison of the percentage without, to the population of all those without internet

Population Distribution - Comparison of the percentage of people, to the total population of all wage brackets

With Internet - Comparison of the percentage of people who have internet, to the total population

Percentage of Population (Without) - Comparison of the number of people without, to the total population
